**PROP/SET DROP OFF SCHEDULE** Like last year, we will be offering two prop drop off options. A few teams requested to drop off Friday night. Gym prop drop for Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>, will be from 7:00-9:00 PM. The building will be open Saturday at 6:00-6:55 am for prop drop off.

**\*\* ALL PROPS need to be DONE by 6:55 AM....our first floor practice is at 7:00 AM sharp.**

We need each school to contact our Prop Coordinator, Steve Pfeifer, [stevep@canby.com](mailto:stevep@canby.com), to sign up for a team time to drop off your props.

**TEAM ARRIVAL / DROP OFF** The building will be open at 6:00 a.m. for your teams. If you need earlier entry, just contact Karalee. Buses should drive to the main front entrance of the school to drop off team members, costumes, and food. You will find your team packets ready for you upon arrival at team check-in, and your Cougar Dancer hostess will meet you there. In your packet you will find 5 parent helper wrist bands and coaches' passes. Up to THREE additional wrist bands may be purchased for Mom helpers at \$5 each during the 9:30 a.m. coaches' meeting.

**FLOOR PRACTICE** Attached in this packet is the schedule for floor practice in the performance gym (10 minutes for dance/drill; 15 minutes for show). If you elect not to use this practice time, please let us know in advance. Bring your music to our sound tech at your practice time and inform him of what seems to work best for your music. If you experience any problems or have any questions please come and meet with us, as we want your team's performance to be at its best! Please PROVIDE a music person for practice & performance. SHOW TEAM'S PROPS NEED TO BE UNLOADED INTO GYM BETWEEN DESIGNATED TIMES> NOT DURING FLOOR PRACTICE PLEASE.

**PERFORMANCE / JUDGING** – We will have 4A, 5A, 6A and Show Division included in this competition. This event is festival seating/judging. Please bring a USB drive (AKA flash drive, thumb drive) clearly labeled with your school name to the coaches' meeting. Also, bring your completed Announcers Sheet to the coaches' meeting. Performance order for both rounds is included in this packet. Notice that Novice Drill Down and Advanced Drill Down will both take place at the end of Round Two.

**TEAM ROOMS** – The faculty and staff of Canby High have graciously made their classrooms available. Due to limited space and electrical outlets in our cafeteria, you may use outlets in your team room to plug in small appliances to keep food warm (crock pots, etc.). Please inform those providing food for your team that there are no microwaves or kitchen facilities available. There will be tables in the cafeteria reserved for your team to eat.

**PRACTICE GYM and DANCE ROOM** – Located near the team rooms is a regulation size gym that is available to any team wanting to rehearse, pattern, stretch, etc. We will have a sign-up sheet posted at the gym entrance for 15-minute blocks. Please limit to 2 time slots per team for gym use..

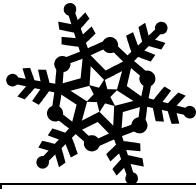
### **CONCESSIONS / VENDORS**

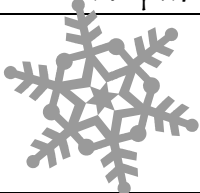

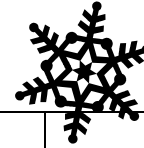
